Mayor and Councilor Reports and Forums

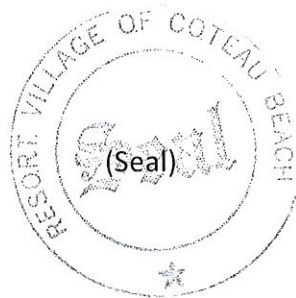
